Independence Hall - Independence Hall - In 1776, the Second Continental Congress signed the Declaration of Independence here. Eleven years later, in the same room, delegates to the Constitutional Convention created and signed an enduring framework of government - the United States Constitution. Although known today as Independence Hall, the building was constructed to be the Pennsylvania State House. It once housed all three branches of Pennsylvania's colonial government.

Carpenters Hall - Carpenters' Hall is a treasure in historic Philadelphia. It hosted the First Continental Congress in 1774 and was home to Franklin's Library Company, The American Philosophical Society, and the First and Second Banks of the United States.

Arlington National Cemetery - Arlington National Cemetery is one of the country's oldest national cemeteries. The cemetery's rolling hills mark the final resting place for more than 14,000 veterans, including those who fought in the Civil War. The cemetery also offers a final resting place for residents of the Armed Forces Retirement Home – Washington. miles, is where Robert E. Lee made his worst mistake of the war, giving the north a victory that would signal the eventual end of the conflict. We begin our journey here with a Narrated Battlefield Riding Tour. We will stop at Robert E. Lee Memorial - View Pickett's Charge Battlefield - Drive through the Wheat Fields and along Devil's Den - Ascend Little Round Top - Cross over Cemetery Ridge(Union Side) - and reach the High Water Mark of the Confederacy. You will also see the National Cemetery where President Lincoln gave his famous Gettysburg Address. After our riding tour we arrive at the visitors center to see the film "Fields of Freedom" depicting the sounds and fury of the battle at Gettysburg. Time is provided to enjoy the "Cyclorama" along with time to visit the Gettysburg Battle Museum.

Student/Chaperone Code of Conduct:
